Scholarship Guidelines

IMPORTANT: Please read all the guidelines before completing this application. All applications MUST be typed. Application forms are in PDF format. Complete the application and SAVE it to your computer. You must print the application. Application must include: the application form, the authorization form signed by an FFA Advisor, 4-H Leader or County Extension Agent, and a high school transcript.

Application Deadline: The deadline for submitting applications is June 1, 2020. Applications will be accepted if postmarked on or before that date. Applications must be mailed to the address shown above or hand delivered to the North Dakota State Fair office by the application deadline.

Scholarship Drawing: All qualified students who submit an application will be sent an invitation to attend the “Friends of the Fair Reception” during the North Dakota State Fair on Wednesday, July 22, 2020. All candidates who attend will be honored as the “North Dakota State Fair Graduating Class of 2020.” The names of all attendees will be randomly drawn and six graduates will be awarded a \$1000 scholarship at this event. ***Candidates must be present to win.***

Scholarship Amounts: The amount of the scholarship is currently \$1000. Six (6) \$1000 scholarships are available.

THE FOLLOWING ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA APPLY TO ALL APPLICANTS:

Citizenship: The applicant must be a citizen of the United States or have been born in the United States and be a resident of the State of North Dakota.

Academic Standing: The applicant must be a graduating high school senior in 2020 and meet the minimum requirement of a 2.0 GPA.

College/University Acceptance/Enrollment: The applicant must have plans to enroll in any accredited post-secondary education institution in the 2020-2021 school year.

North Dakota State Fair Involvement: Candidates must have a minimum of 4 years experience exhibiting and/or competing in 4-H and/or FFA at the North Dakota State Fair.

Reference: Each application must include the verification form with the signature of a 4-H Leader, FFA Advisor or County Extension Agent confirming the candidate has a minimum 4 years of exhibiting and/or competing in 4-H or FFA at the North Dakota State Fair.

Eligibility: Applicants must be present for the scholarship drawing at the North Dakota State Fair on July 22, 2020. Only those present will be included in the random drawing.
